Deadline to submit your \$500 enrollment deposit. The deposit is refundable with written request submitted prior to May 1.



Housing assignments are made based upon the date the online intention is first finalized. Changes, including roommate requests, can be made until May 15. Housing assignments and roommate assignments are emailed in July.




